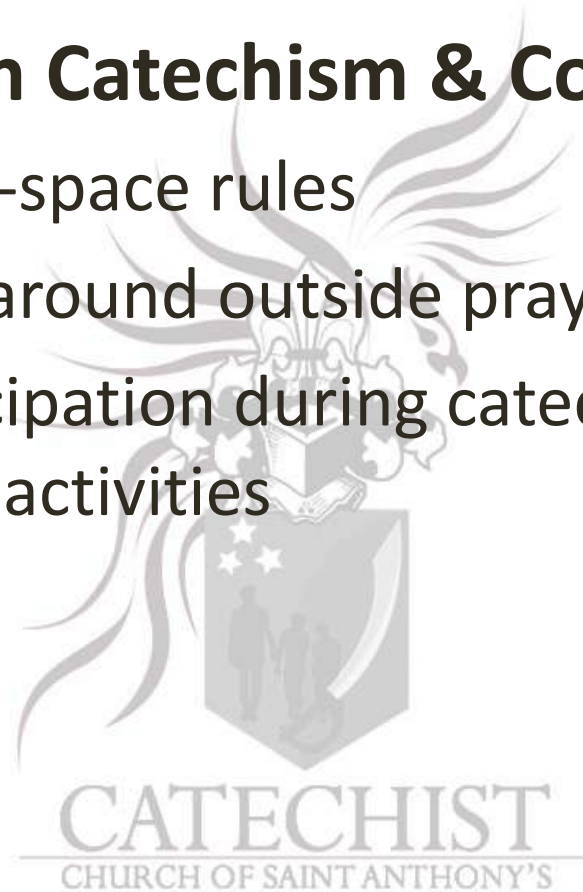

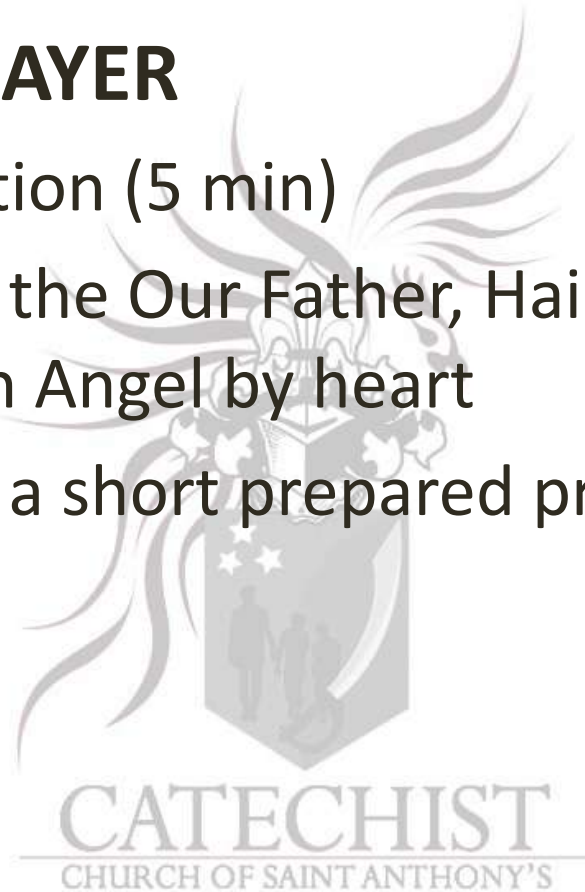

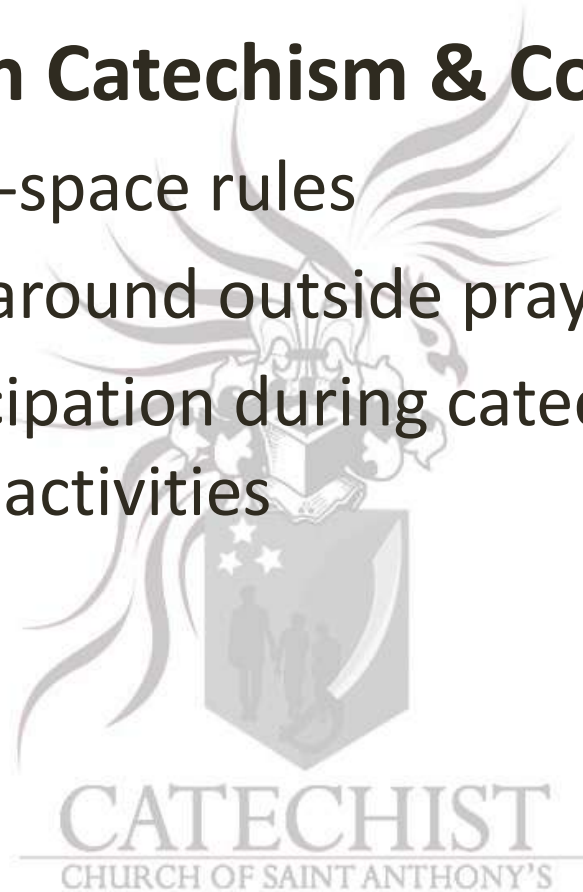

- All Parents & Children will be required to participate in the program to receive the Sacrament.

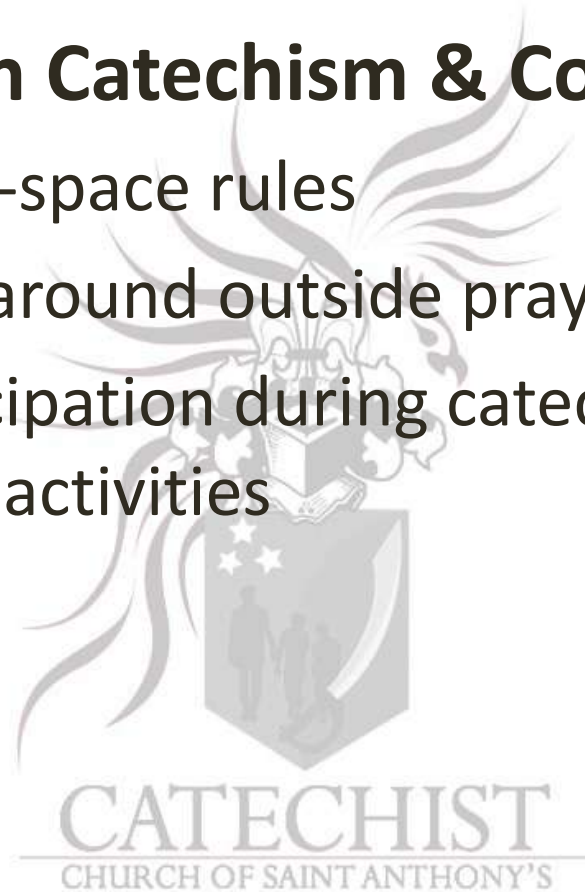

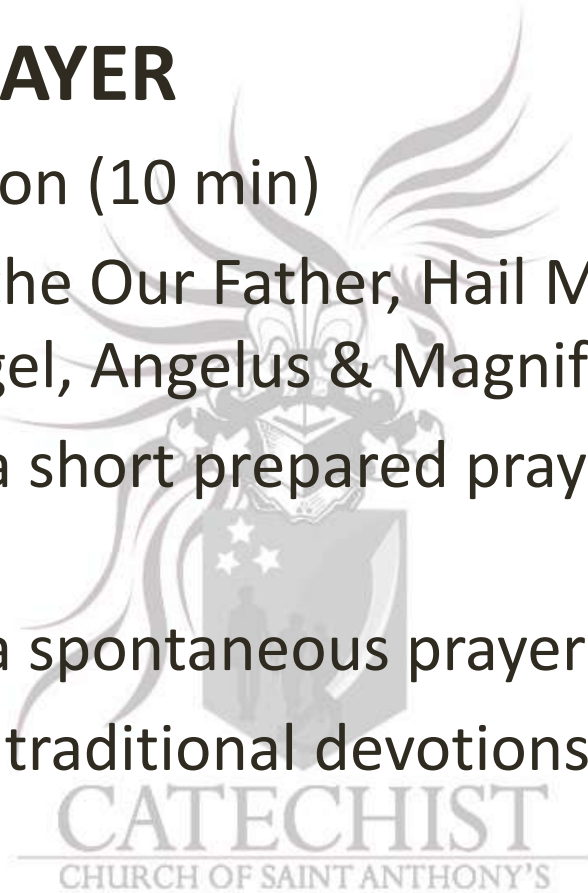
Introduction to Ministries

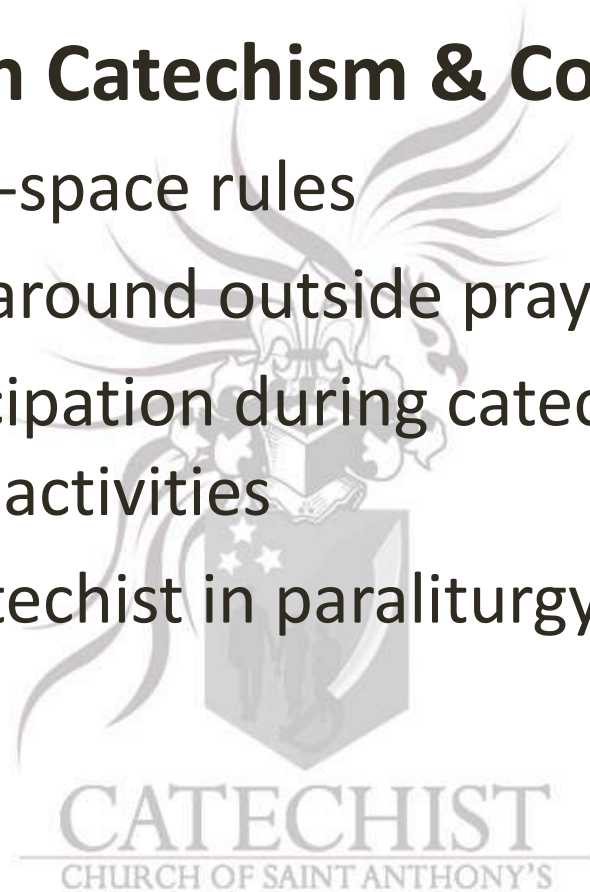

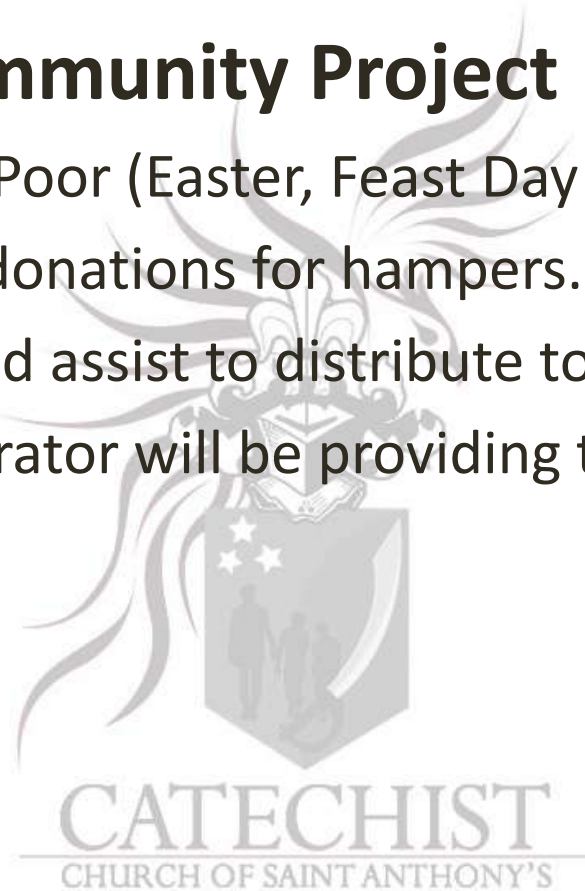
