MASS UPDATE

Livestream Masses (revised timing)

- we will only be livestreaming the following weekend Masses from 1 April onwards.
- Saturday Sunset Mass (5.30pm)
- Sunday 9.15am Mass

Please note that all weekday Masses will no longer be livestreamed. We encourage more Parishioners to return to Mass in April as we will be increasing our capacities for Mass. Effective April, no booking is required for weekday Masses but check-in by scanning of NRIC is still required.

We will be closing the gates 15 minutes before Mass timing due to pre Mass preparations. MARS will cater for the gate closure timing. Once gates are closed, we seek your understanding that we would not be able to allow Parishioners to enter.

Increased in Mass capacity in April

- All Masses in April will be increased to 300 pax.
- Masses from Maundy Thursday onwards will be 400 pax.

We encourage more Parishioners to please join us physically for Mass in church.

Palm Sunday

- please take note that there will be procession with the palms on Saturday 9 April.
- we will begin the Procession at 5pm. Gates will close at 4.45pm.
