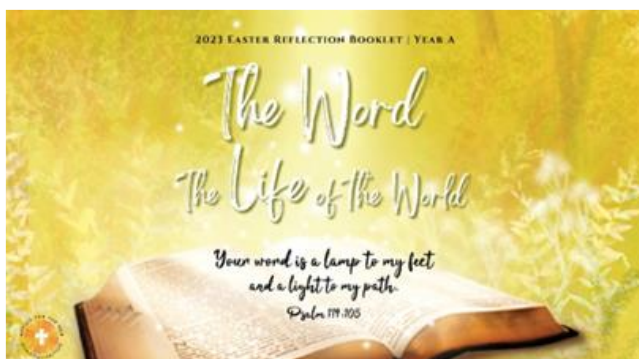


### **EASTER REFLECTIONS**




### **GIFT 2<sup>ND</sup> COLLECTION ON 15/16**
