WORLD GRANDPARENTS AND ELDERLY DAY

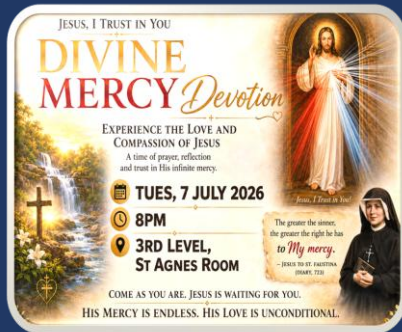
