AROUND THE ARCHDIOCESE

Appeal for Nepal Flood Emergency Relief

Caritas Humanitarian Aid & Relief Initiatives, Singapore (CHARIS), is making an urgent appeal for those affected by the recent disaster in Nepal. On 26 August 2026, a devastating flash flood struck Rasuwa District, Nepal, after the Bhote Koshi River overflowed. Over 1,000 people have been reported dead and more than 3,900 remain missing, with thousands more displaced and left without necessities. Search and rescue efforts continue as families face total loss of shelter, food, and livelihoods.

CHARIS is raising funds to support Caritas Nepal and on-ground partners in providing immediate emergency assistance, including shelter, food, clean water, essential supplies, and long-term recovery efforts.
